Thank you to everyone that came along and a special thanks to my navigator Caitlin for all of her help during the cruise.

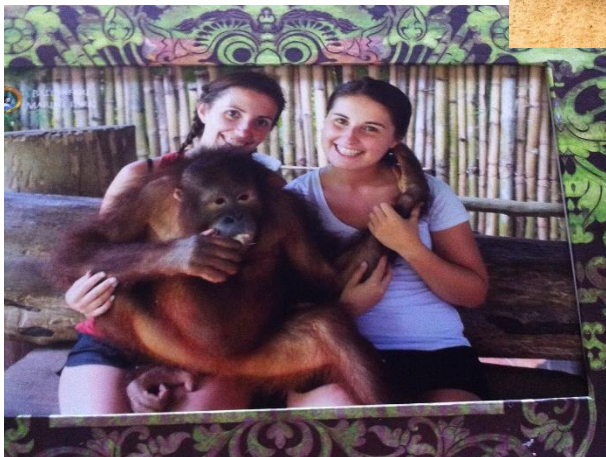

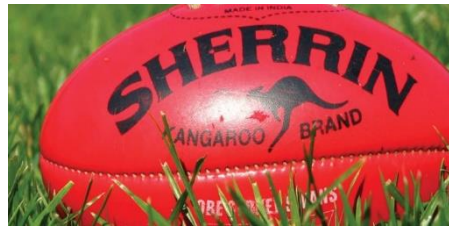
