Once again thanks to Connor for the great route.



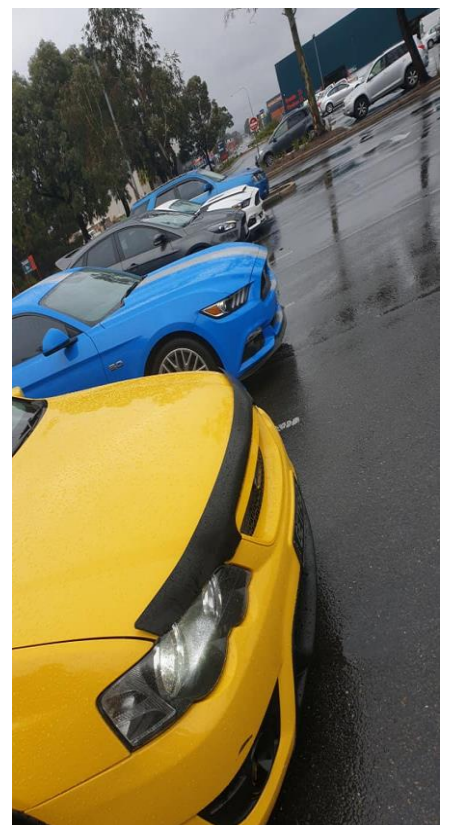
Covid Comeback Cruise – Curvy – 13th June Hosted by Connor and Caitlin
